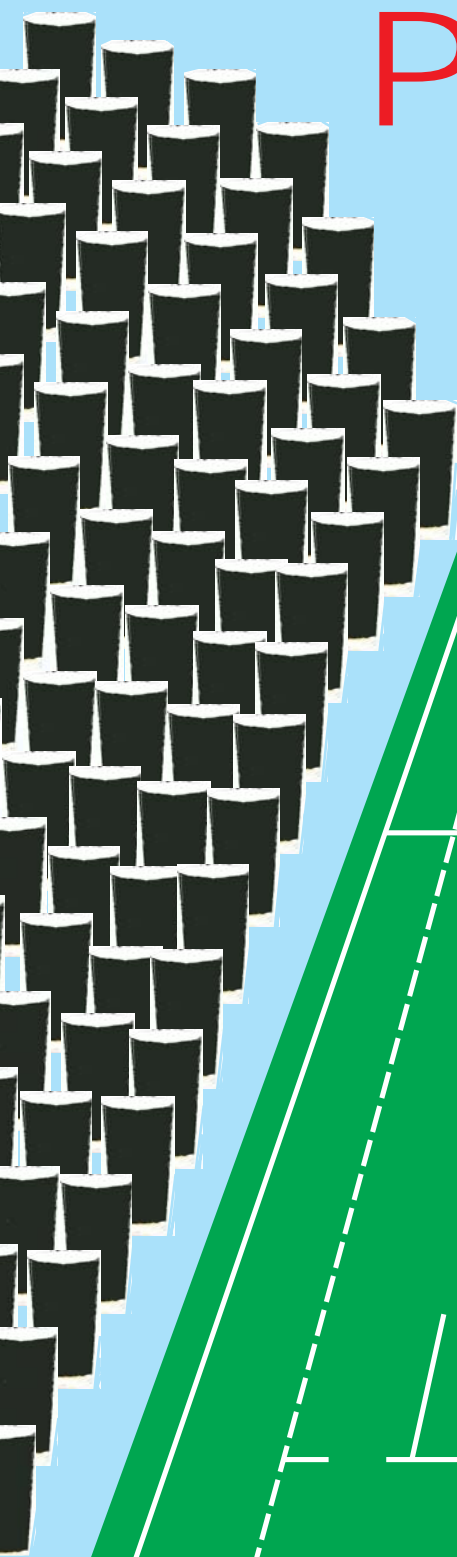

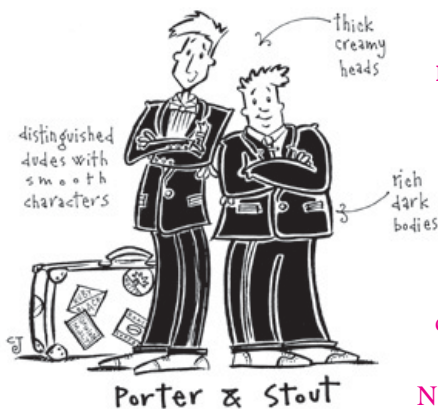

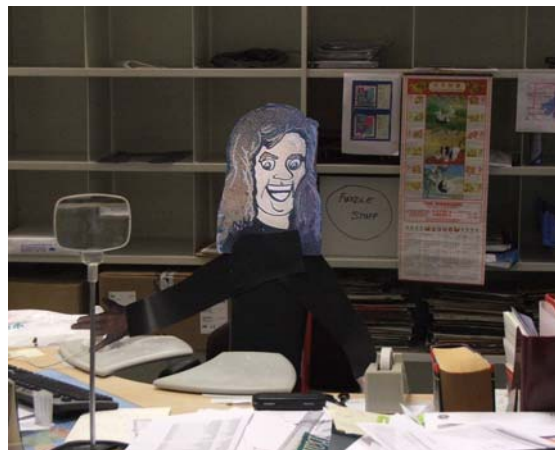
This is the second Nottingham CAMRA Stout and Porter trail. It's nearly three weeks of campaigning in order to promote two of the oldest beer styles still supped in Britain today.

The Trail will take place from Monday, 6th March through to Saturday, 25th March 2006. There are eighteen pubs taking part - the Stout and Porter team. To support them, just visit the pubs to find out what is available; many outlets will be stocking several different beers throughout the trail. Once you have sampled your chosen tippie, shade the pint glass in the corresponding team member. Once you've visited all eighteen you've completed your trail - what could be simpler?

Look out for Sooty Stout from Nottingham Brewery, Nottingham Dark Stout from Castle Rock, All Black from Everards Brewery, Stout Fellow from Caythorpe, Railway Porter from Brunswick, Black Pearl from Milestone, Puritans Porter from Springhead and many other stouts and porters that will be available throughout the trail.

Hardys & Hansons are brewing Celtic Black for St Patricks Day. The beer is described as having roasted malts to provide a deep smoky character and English hops to provide the dry finish to making it a complex and satisfying dark brew. The beer will be available in many of Hardys & Hansons pubs that normally stock their seasonal beer. One of them is the Bell, which is holding a Light and Dark Beer Festival from Sunday 12th to Sunday 19th March featuring the Ray Kirby selection of stouts and porters.

Caythorpe Brewery's "Stout Fellow" proved so popular with the locals when it was first tried at the Reindeer in Hoveringham that it has become a permanent fixture, replacing the Guinness on the bar.
